North Wilkesboro Speedway: 0.625-mile semi-banked oval. Located four miles east of North Wilkesboro on US 421. INFORMATION: P.O. Box 337, North Wilkesboro, NC 28659. (919-667-6663)

Phoenix International Raceway: 1-mile, semi-banked oval. Located west of Phoenix on I-10, then six miles south on 115th St. INFORMATION: P.O. Box 13088, Phoenix, AZ 85002. (602-252-3883)
